

Check your toilets for leaks

Put 12 drops of food coloring in your toilet tank. Do not flush For 1 hour. If the color begins to appear in the bowl you have a leak that should be repaired immediately.

Be sure to call before you dig – it's the law. Require 48 Hour Notice before your scheduled dig. Calling 811 before every digging job gets your underground utility lines marked for free and helps prevent undesired consequences.

Water during the early parts of the day; avoid watering when it's windy. Early morning watering, and late watering, also reduce water loss to evaporation.
